Initiation à la voile et Découverte de la Côte Catalane

CLUB ROTARY PERPIGNAN LOGE DE MER

The 23rd edition of the Youth Camp organized by the Rotary Loge de Mer is still popular under the name of "Initiation to sailing and discovery of the Catalan coasts".

It is organized from Saturday June 20 to Monday June 29, 2020.

It is open to 8 boys or girls from 8 different countries and speaking French or English, aged 18 to 22.

The objective is to discover the French and Spanish Catalan Coast through initiation to sailing on a modern catamaran (Notitech 470, see photos) equipped with 4 double bedrooms with bathroom and WC in each bedroom plus 2 furnished points of 2 beds each for skippers.

The teaching of sailing will be carried out by a professional skipper assisted by a Rotarian from the Perpignan Loge de Mer club, who will be accommodated in 2 independent rooms at the front of the catamaran.

Participants will be accommodated on the catamaran from Saturday June 22 to Friday June 26 and then in a Mobile Home at Camping Taxo les Pins 4 * in Argeles sur Mer from Friday June 26 to Monday June 29.

The amount of the participation of each young person is fixed at 400 €.

Program:

• Saturday June 20: welcoming of participants and installation on the catamaran in Port Leucate. Meals taken together in the evening at Port Leucate

• Sunday June 21: navigation to Port La Nouvelle, evening reception and dinner at the Rotary Club of Port La Nouvelle

• Monday June 22: navigation to the Costa Brava and fairground mooring in a cove (depending on the weather). Meal taken on the catamaran, possibility of discovering the seabed in snorkeling

• Tuesday 23 June: navigation to Rosas in Spain, stopover in Rosas, typical "Tapas" meal taken together in a restaurant in Rosas

• Wednesday June 24: navigation to Collioure with fairground mooring in Collioure bay, discovery of the city and meal taken on the catamaran, tasting of local products.

• Thursday 25 June: navigation to Saint Cyprien, stopover in Cyprien and barbecue organized in the gardens of the Harbor master's office of Saint Cyprien.

• Friday June 26: Navigation to Port Leucate, and Installation in the Mobile Homes in Argeles at Camping Taxo Les pins.

• Saturday June 27: Relaxation day at Camping Taxo Les pins, access to all the campsite activities and meals taken on site.

• Sunday June 28: Reception by the Rotary Club Loge de Mer, Camp Closing Meal.

• Monday June 29: Departure of participants to their homes.
