Among these 2000 children we have full sponsorship by LPGM for 1120 kids and another 160 children get part of the expenses (50% only) and the rest of them are in dire need of sponsorship.

I take this opportunity to thank you for your passion towards finding some support to take care of our disadvantaged children.

As you know from your/ my visit earlier and the telecom discussions, we have nearly 14 children Boarding hostels run by Arcot Lutheran Church from very small to big having from 30 to 600 kids a few them are aged more than 120 years. All the homes are
