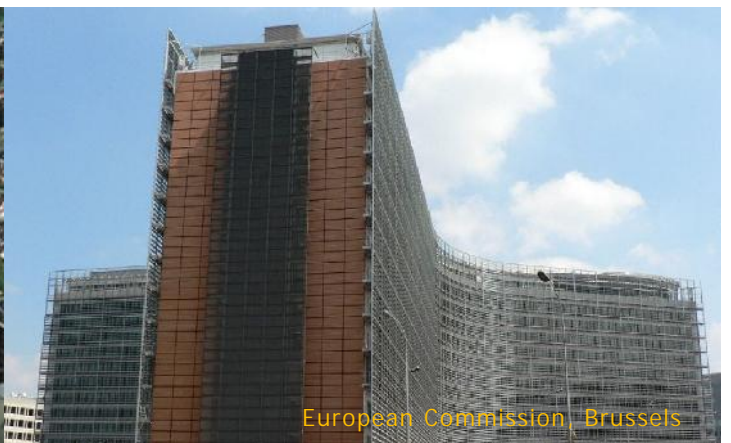

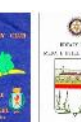

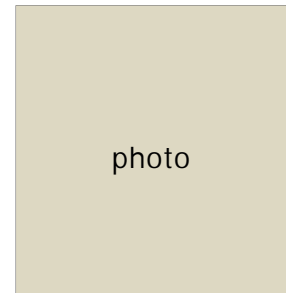

RULES AND OBLIGATIONS

Youngster's profile

The candidate for this trip is a young boy or girl aged 18 to 20 years. He/she is mature, enthusiastic about this trip, extroverted, tolerant and open-minded towards different cultures.

English speaking capability is mandatory. He/she is fit and healthy. No excessive sports capabilities will be required. However, the ability to ride a bicycle and/or to swim is assumed. Allergies and specific dietary requirements, if any, should be mentioned on the application form.

Candidates will be proposed by a Rotary Club in their own country and will need his/her parents' authorization. Rotary Club may, at their own initiative, offer subsidy for the trip to Milan and back home from Luxemburg as well as for participation fee and/or pocket money.

This trip is made possible thanks to ten Rotary Clubs and is intended to serve the goals of Rotary International, in particular the promotion of peace through a better mutual understanding. It is a requirement that youngsters should get informed / inform themselves about Rotary by their sponsoring Rotary Club or on their own initiative through internet before their departure.

Code of conduct

The Europe for Europe participant shall comply with all laws and regulations of the visited host countries. If found guilty of violating any laws, he/she shall return home at his/her own expense, once released by the authorities.

Furthermore, the applicant shall comply with the rules and conditions of the Europe for Europe program, as set forth herewith, and shall obey any instructions given by members of host Rotary Clubs in each country.

Possessing or using illegal drugs and excessive drinking are forbidden. However, medications duly prescribed by a physician are allowed. Smoking and drinking alcoholics are discouraged.

During the whole duration of the program, participants may not operate a motorized vehicle, including but not limited to cars, trucks, motorcycles, aircraft, all-terrain vehicles, snow mobiles, boats, and other watercraft.

In case of non-compliance with the above mentioned rules and obligations, the offenders will be ordered to return home at their own expense.

Participants should talk with a Rotary Club member or other trusted adult, if encountering any form of abuse or harassment.

Youngsters should find fulfillment in participating to the Europe for Europe program by developing their capabilities,

treating others with honesty, dignity,

respect and sensitivity, appreciating the values of diversity and team spirit.

Insurance

A copy of a European Medical Insurance Card is to be attached to the application form. If not, insurance shall be taken at an independent insurer at the applicant's own cost.

Such insurance shall be valid for the duration of the whole Europe for Europe program from the time of departure from the home country until the return to the home country.

It shall cover, among others, accidental injury and illness, third party liability, death benefits (including repatriation of remains), disability / dismemberment be-nefits, emergency medical evacuation, emergency evacuation expenses, 24-hour emergency assistance, and legal services.

If required by the host Rotary Clubs, the youngster shall allow the former to examine the original insurance policies, or alternatively deliver copies of them, certified by the Insurance Company.

He/she may not invoke a lack of insurance coverage or failure of insurers in order to escape from obligations under the Europe for Europe program.

During the trip, the hosting Rotary Clubs will provide stand-by medical care from amongst their members with the appropriate classification and assume responsibility for calling upon possible emergency medical care where and when required.

Transport cost & other expenses

The transport cost to Milan, which is the meeting place and the start of the journey for the 28 youngsters, and the transport cost from Luxemburg back to their country of origin shall be covered by the youngsters' parents.

Bus transport during the trip and between the different countries is provided by the organizers. Youngsters will stay at youth hostels or hotels or at the home of Rotary members or their friends.

All meals and other expenses will be covered by the organizers, except pocket money expenses.

Upon the applicant final selection (there can be just one per country), a participation fee of three hundred Euros (300 €) shall be paid to the Belgian Rotary Club who coordinates this E4E-edition. This fee covers the transport between the different countries.

In case of cancellation of the trip by the youngster, whatever the reason might be, this fee will not be refunded.

Youngsters shall purchase their return ticket before departure from the home country. The return home will be done directly from Luxemburg airport.

Youngsters shall return home as scheduled. Organizers decline any responsibility, should a youngster decide to stay longer.

Declarations of the Applicant
